Actions from meeting 1 Constitution Finance Update Summer Camp Update AOB

- 1. Actions from meeting 1
 - Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC) status: Matt has checked this and a copy of the Constitution has to be sent to Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs to check and register us. He can do this once the Constitution is agreed.
 - David C: Companies donating to a CASC should benefit as it is eligible for tax relief.
 - Emails & Insurance & Competent Persons: Jackie emailed & wrote to Owen Jones of Sports Wales. Reply has been received, Jackie read it out.
 - Approach Scott Ashman or Andy Roberts to act as player representative on Committee: Matt decided to approach Scott only, as he had already agreed to help with the first aid and has shown a lot of commitment to the Club since joining last season. Scott accepted the invitation.
 - Constitution: Has been checked and amended by David C, Lindsay and Matt, who are now happy with the final result. Just needs to be signed by Executive Officers.
 - Check with Scott re fist aid: Scott has agreed to act as a first aider and brought copies of his certificates.
 - Ask David McPherson to get CRB forms for Brett Henson and Lindsay: Lindsay and Brett's checks are in hand.

Scott also now needs to be checked.

Matt also asked that his friend Michael Walters be checked as he is a better photographer than Matt, therefore he wants to ask him to the August camp to take photos.
